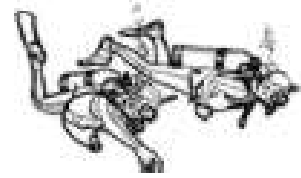

The **Advanced Open Water** "training" dives will be conducted at various commercially operated quarries for scuba divers in Western Ohio.

The **Advanced Open Water Diver** program has something for everyone. This exciting program includes a total of five adventure dives from the following list (**must include deep and navigation dive**):

If you're 15 or older, and a PADI Open Water Diver or equivalent, then you're ready for the Advanced Open Water Diver program. Or, if you're a PADI Junior Open Water Diver or equivalent and between the ages of 12-14, there is the PADI Junior Advanced Open Water Diver program.

After successfully completing the course, you'll receive the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver certification. This allows you to participate in more advanced diving activities with a maximum recommended depth limit of 30 metres/100 feet, in addition to the qualifications listed for PADI Open Water Divers.

What does this program offer you? New experiences, new skills, lots of diving and thrilling adventures! So take your diving to new limits!

PADI - Advanced Open Water Scuba Course

OPTION 1: The Original PADI Advanced Open Water Course - Course Fee of \$298.60 includes:

- Classroom & Open Water Dives (\$225.00)
- Student Kit (\$73.60) - which includes:
 - PADI Advanced Open Water Text book
 - Data Carrier Slate
 - Safety Sausage

All Students Must have (but is not included in above kit):

- PADI Continuing Education Log Book Pages or PADI Blue Divers Log Book (if needed)

Registration:

We require a \$50.00 deposit (of the above course fee) to hold your place in class. The course fees are **non-refundable**, but are transferable if you need to change class dates.

Home study:

You need to read the textbook completely and do the five knowledge reviews (one for each of the dives you will be doing) at the end of each respective chapter. Please have these ready to review during the classroom session.

Forms:

You must completely fill out a student record file, liability release, Safe Diving Practices and Medical Statement at the time of registration. If you are a minor, you must also have your parent or guardian sign in all the sections where you have signed. Medical forms must be filled in with the words YES or NO spelled out. If you have a YES answer, that does not mean you cannot dive or take the class, but it does mean that we will need to have a PADI Medical Form filled out and signed by your doctor PRIOR to participation in the pool sessions. There can be no exceptions.

Picture:

We will take a digital picture of you during the classroom session for your certification card.

Equipment:

If you need to rent equipment, we can arrange that, the equipment rental fees are **not included** in the course price.

- Online registration with PADI (\$120.00 - payable right to PADI by credit card)

You need to be at least 13 years old to participate in PADI eLearning, due to international internet laws. (If you're younger than this, you can still learn to dive - have your parent or legal guardian contact a PADI Dive Center or Resort near you.)

Registration:

You pay online with PADI for the eLearning portion. We require a \$50.00 deposit (of the above course fee) to hold your place for the classroom session & open water dives. The course fees are **non-refundable**, but are transferable if you need to change class dates.

Forms:

You must completely fill out a student record file, liability release, Safe Diving Practices and Medical Statement at the time of registration, some of these forms are filled out with PADI when you register online - so please print them off & bring with you. If you are a minor, you must also have your parent or guardian sign in all the sections where you have signed. Medical forms must be filled in with the words YES or NO spelled out. If you have a YES answer, that does not mean you cannot dive or take the class, but it does mean that we will need to have a PADI Medical Form filled out and signed by your doctor PRIOR to participation in the pool sessions. There can be no exceptions.

Picture:

We will take a digital picture of you during the class & pool sessions.

Equipment:

If you need to rent equipment, we can arrange that, the equipment rental fees are **not included** in the course price.

Other Class Information:

 - White Star Quarry
 - Gilboa Quarry
 - Circleville Twin Quarries
 - Portage Quarry
- Some other fees that are NOT included, but need to be considered:
 - Quarry admission fees
 - Lodging (hotel or camping)
 - Transportation
 - Airfills
 - Food
