OPEN WATER CLASSROOM & POOL SCHEDULE:

Extended Weekend Format:

Friday 6PM - 10PM Classroom Only
Saturday 9AM - 8PM AM Classroom / PM Pool
Sunday 9AM - 6PM AM Pool / PM Classroom

Entire classroom & pool course is completed in 1 weekend. Classroom instruction is held at Atlantis Outfitters.
Pool instruction is held at various local indoor pools (Canton & Akron).

Open water "training" dives will be conducted at various commercially operated quarries for scuba divers in Western Ohio. 1 weekend of open water training will be available usually within one month of completion of classroom & pool training, from May until November. Referrals are available for any student traveling to warm water locations any time of the year.

PADI - Open Water Scuba Course

Atlantis Outfitters offers a beginning Scuba Diving Course that makes it fun and surprisingly easy to learn to Scuba Dive. All of our courses are approved by the Professional Association of Diving Instructors (PADI), the world's largest training organization. We emphasize quality instruction through smaller classes and individualized attention. Let us introduce you to the beauty & adventure of the underwater world. To enroll in a class or for more information, please feel free to contact us or stop by the store.

OPTION 1: The Original PADI Open Water Course - Course Fee of \$292.90 includes:

(This does NOT include the open water training dives, see below for those fees)

- Classroom & Pool Sessions (\$225.00)
- Student Kit (\$67.90) - which includes:
 - PADI Text book
 - PADI Student Record File
 - PADI Electronic Recreational Dive Planner - Multi level (E-RDPML)
 - PADI Divers Log Book
- Use of ALL Scuba equipment for pool sessions, excluding mask, fins and snorkel (to be purchase by student).
- An additional "refundable" Video Deposit of \$25.00 is required for use of the DVD (which is required to be viewed PRIOR to the classroom sessions) and will be refunded to the student upon return of the DVD to Atlantis Outfitters.



Registration:

We require a \$50.00 deposit (of the above course fee) to hold your place in class. The course fees are **non-refundable**, but are transferable if you need to change class dates.

Dates and Times:

You need to be at the store promptly at 6 PM on Friday and at the times that your instructor tells you for Saturday and Sunday. This class is arranged in 5 modules, which must be completed in order. Friday's session must be completed first, followed by Saturday, followed by Sunday. You may be required to come in on an evening after your classroom and pool for a personal consultation with your instructor.

Home study:

You need to read the textbook completely and do the five knowledge reviews at the end of each chapter. Start at the beginning, read the introduction, and do the quick quizzes as you go along. This will help you when you do the knowledge reviews. Do not hand in a blank piece of paper with just the answers; we will need to collect your knowledge reviews for your student file. Please have these ready to review during the classroom sessions. This homework needs to be completed **before** you come to class on Friday evening. During the classroom, you will have a quiz after each of the first four chapters and a final exam after the last chapter.

Forms:

You must completely fill out a student record file, liability release, Safe Diving Practices and Medical Statement at the time of registration. If you are a minor, you must also have your parent or guardian sign in all the sections where you have signed. Medical forms must be filled in with the words YES or NO spelled out. If you have a YES answer, that does not mean you cannot dive or take the class, but it does mean that we will need to have a PADI Medical Form filled out and signed by your doctor PRIOR to participation in the pool sessions. There can be no exceptions.

Picture:

We will take a digital picture of you during the class & pool sessions.

OPTION 2: The NEW PADI eLearning Home Online Study - Course Fees listed below

(This does NOT include the open water training dives, see below for those fees)

Begin your scuba certification online - where you can complete the classroom portion of the PADI Open Water Diver course at your own pace, anytime, anywhere with PADI eLearning.

While you're working through the PADI Open Water Diver Course Online or after you complete all the segments, you can print your eLearning record and bring it in to Atlantis Outfitters to start the next phase in your underwater adventure.

PADI eLearning gives you:

- .. Convenient online access to knowledge development course materials for one year.
- .. Unrestricted access to an online version of the PADI Open Water Diver Manual.
- .. Learning at your own pace and on your own schedule.
- .. The option to visit or contact Atlantis Outfitters anytime during business hours.

You need to be at least 13 years old to participate in PADI eLearning, due to international internet laws. (If you're younger than this, you can still learn to dive - have your parent or legal guardian contact a PADI Dive Center or Resort near you.)

Course Fees:

- Online registration with PADI (\$120.00 - payable right to PADI by credit card)
- Pool Sessions w/Atlantis Outfitters (\$175.00)
- Student eLearning Kit (\$45.65) - which includes:
 - PADI Student Record File
 - PADI Electronic Recreational Dive Planner - Multi level (E-RDPML)
 - PADI Divers Log Book
- Use of ALL Scuba equipment for pool sessions, excluding mask, fins and snorkel (to be purchased by student).

Registration:

You pay online with PADI for the eLearning portion. We require a \$50.00 deposit (of the above course fee) to hold your place for the pool training. The course fees are **non-refundable**, but are transferable if you need to change class dates.

Dates and Times:

You need to be at the store promptly at 2:30 PM on Saturday for gear fitting, then will go to the pool for the 1st 4-hour pool session, and meet back at the pool the next day, at the time that your instructor tells you, for your 2nd 4-hour pool session.

Forms:

You must completely fill out a student record file, liability release, Safe Diving Practices and Medical Statement at the time of registration, some of these forms are filled out with PADI when you register online - so please print them off & bring with you. If you are a minor, you must also have your parent or guardian sign in all the sections where you have signed. Medical forms must be filled in with the words YES or NO spelled out. If you have a YES answer, that does not mean you cannot dive or take the class, but it does mean that we will need to have a PADI Medical Form filled out and signed by your doctor PRIOR to participation in the pool sessions. There can be no exceptions.

Picture:

We will take a digital picture of you during the class & pool sessions.

Equipment:

We provide all the equipment you need for either of the course formats above, except Mask, Fins and Snorkel. If you purchase these items from Atlantis Outfitters, you will receive a 10% student discount. If you have equipment you have already purchased, we will need to see the equipment on Friday evening to be sure it is suitable for scuba.

After the Classroom and Pool have been finished:

When you have finished your classroom and pool sessions, you will need to do four open water dives to become a PADI certified diver. You have one year in which to complete these four dives.

Our PADI Open Water "Local" Training Dives - Course Fee of \$185.00 includes:

- 4 Open Water Training Dives (\$125.00) (required for certification - 1 weekend)
 - Completed during the months of May through November
 - We use the following quarries:
 - White Star Quarry
 - Gilboa Quarry
 - Circleville Twin Quarries
 - Portage Quarry
- Equipment rental (\$60.00 - special student rate) (excluding mask, fins, snorkel)
- Some other fees that are NOT included, but need to be considered:
 - Quarry admission fees
 - Lodging (hotel or camping)
 - Transportation
 - Airfills
 - Food



If you prefer to do your Open Water dives on a trip, you would need to obtain a "referral packet" from us, this fee is \$25.00 per person; and enables you to do your dives at any PADI facility world-wide.

PADI Courses are approved for College Credit by A.C.E.
